

Summer Horse Camp - Hours: 8am to 5pm*

* at no extra charge, campers can stay from 2pm - 5pm & work with the camp counselor in the barn. Don't worry no stall cleaning!

Camp is an opportunity for your child(ren) to experience and learn the enjoyment and responsibility of horsemanship. That is what we offer here at Schunnemunk Shadow Stables for riders age 6 and up (call us if you have a child who is younger that wants attend). Our camp provides instruction for campers just learning to ride and also teaches the finer points for the more experienced. Campers will get to choose to focus on either learning Western or English. They will learn every aspect involved with horsemanship including the care and feeding of horses, respect for the horse, both English and Western terminology, saddle and bridle parts, horse body parts, and of course, learn to ride. Every camper will ride daily and have an opportunity learn another discipline - how to drive (cart) a miniature horse.

Camp weeks are for all levels of riders. In each week instructors will break the group apart according to discipline and level but the group will stay together for horsemanship and horse science.

Riding Helmets:

Riding helmets are required for all horse campers (children and adults) and are provided by Schunnemunk. Campers are encouraged to purchase their own to ensure proper fit and availability. Schunnemunk patrons receive a 10% discount at Whinnies and Knickers Tack store in Newburgh, NY.

Apparel:

Long pants and heeled boot are required. A change of clothes can be worn when not handling or riding horses.

Tuition Fee:

Cost for camp is the same every week except for Adult Days. Deposits **MUST BE IN BY MAY 15th** or there will be a \$25 late charge.

English/Western Camp:

Tuition is \$350 for the week. Discount available for multiple week or VIP - Summer Session (7wk) sign ups. Call for info.

Adult/Advanced Camp:

Tuition is \$210 for intensive 3 days. Please contact office for more information.

Bring:

There is a 1/2hr break for lunch. Campers should bring their own lunch & drink (no glass bottles). Vending machines are provided for snacks. If weather permits, bring towels & swim-suits.
